**World Record Status**

<b>Venue</b>	Lilleshall National Sports and Conferencing Centre, Main Field, TF10 9AT
<b>Rounds</b>	Saturday (Stage 1 of the AGB National Tour): WA720 and H2H Sunday: (The brand new) World Archery Double 720
<b>Faces</b>	One 80cm 6-ring target for each compound archer (4 to a boss). One 122cm face for non-compound archers.
<b>Schedule</b>	Tents can be erected the night before the competition but no earlier than 5pm. No shooting will be available on the Friday night at this time. Registration from 8:00am. Archers will have their equipment inspected and then provide their proof of AGB membership to register. Assembly will be at 8:30am and shooting will commence no later than 8:45am with up to 45 minutes of practice.
<b>Bucks or Bounty</b>	You can enter into either the Bucks or the Bounty category. The Bounty category awards small trophies, the Bucks category awards monetary prizes. Cadet archers and archers shooting bow styles other than recurve or compound may not enter Bucks.
<b>Awards</b>	Bounty: Small trophies to the top three for each gender, cadet and senior, compound, recurve and other. Bucks: Monetary prizes to the top 25% in each of compound men, compound ladies, recurve men and recurve ladies. See the <a href="#">website</a> for a rundown of how the prize amounts are decided. More entries mean more money and more people winning it.
<b>Entry</b>	Entries will be run through <a href="#">Sport:80</a> . The entries open on Thursday 10 <sup>th</sup> January at 7pm, and 7 days earlier for archers ranked in the top 30 in the 2018 national rankings.
<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	Bounty entries are £42, Bucks entries are £50. No single day entries are available. Refunds of 75% are granted to any archer that withdraws by 5 <sup>th</sup> April. No refunds will be granted after this date.
<b>Judges</b>	TBC
<b>Event Information</b>	World Archery Rules will apply. Archers will shoot on Danage bosses. Music will be played during the event. Toilets are located in the pavilion at one end of the field and portable toilets will be placed along the back of the field. Hot food and drink is provided by Lilleshall in the pavilion. Please follow any direction regarding parking on the weekend. Camping is available on site but should be arranged through Lilleshall themselves. Lilleshall do not permit dogs on their grounds unless they are working assistive dogs. Smoking is not permitted in front of the loos at the back of the field. Due to recent theft on Lilleshall grounds we advise all archers to take their equipment away with them between shooting days rather than leaving equipment in their tents.
<b>Drugs</b>	Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK Anti-Doping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.
<b>GDPR</b>	By entering Bucks or Bounty 2019 you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the

year of 2019. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A target list will be published prior to the event in April 2019, available on the Bucks or Bounty website and lanseo. Up-to-date information will be mostly available on lanseo. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible. If you enter the Bucks category and win a monetary prize, you will need to provide your bank details to receive your award.

**Photos** Anyone wishing to take photos at this event must register with the organisers.
