**Venue** Lilleshall National Sports and Conferencing Centre, Bottom Field, TF10 9AT  
Please travel alone if you can and do not bring spectators, any spectators must stay off the field, behind the fence.

**Rounds** Saturday: WA70m for Recurves and Longbows  
Sunday: WA50m for Compounds and Barebows

**Faces** One 80cm 6-ring target for each compound archer (4 to a boss).  
One 122cm face for non-compound archers.

**Schedule**

- **Please time your arrival after 7:15am.**
- **You will be met at the gates by a tournament official who will register you from your car – please have your AGB card ready upon arrival.**
- **You will also be told where you can park upon registration. There will be separate parking for tournament officials and disabled archers so please respect these instructions.**

Line tents can be erected the night before the competition but no earlier than 5pm. No shooting will be available on the Friday night at this time. **See further down for tent area instructions.**

Equipment inspection will occur during practice; judges will come to you and will not touch equipment. If your bow needs it's draw weight testing, bow scales will be sanitised before and after each use.

Assembly will be at 8:30am and shooting will commence no later than 8:45am with up to 45 minutes of practice.

<b>Bucks or Bounty</b>	You can enter into either the Bucks or the Bounty category. The Bounty category awards small trophies, the Bucks category awards monetary prizes. Archers entering as a cadet may not enter Bucks.
<b>Awards</b>	There will be no awards ceremony, please leave the field once you have finished shooting. Bounty: Small trophies to the top three for each gender, Recurve cadet and senior, and compound. These will be posted after the event to the address on the entry. Bucks: Monetary prizes to the top 20% in each of compound men, compound ladies, recurve men and recurve ladies. See the <a href="#">website</a> for a rundown of how the prize amounts are decided. More entries mean more money and more people winning it. Winners will be emailed asking for bank details to transfer prize money.
<b>Entry</b>	Entries will be run through <b>ClubEvent</b> . The entries open on Thursday 17 <sup>th</sup> May at 7pm, and 7 days earlier for archers ranked in the top 30 in the 2019 national rankings.
<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	Bounty entries are £25, Bucks entries are £30. Archers who withdraw for any reason before 19 <sup>th</sup> June 2021 will be entitled to a refund less processing fees. Should the tournament be cancelled for any reason fees will be refunded less processing fees. If you cannot attend due to a positive COVID test or symptoms please inform us as soon as you know and we will refund you less processing fees.
<b>Judges</b>	COJ: Jo Orbell, DOS: Andrew Stanford, Team: Anthony Rides, Holly Hulse, Jasmin Simpson, Lisa Mason, Adam Doughty & Gary Brierley
<b>Tent Areas</b>	There is adequate room behind the shooting line, but to ensure we can all socially distance we're asking you to pitch your tents along your target's lane edge facing into the lane, this gives a 4m wide circulation space and plenty of room to get to the waiting area. See the diagram below. We've extended the lane lines into the tent area to help with this.
<b>PPE &amp; First Aid</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please bring your own PPE. You need to bring a mask to be worn in all indoor spaces or areas that you may not be able to maintain 2m social distance. You do not need to wear a mask when outdoors and distancing but if you are more comfortable doing so then please do.</li> <li>• Bring your own hand sanitiser to keep on your person. There will also be sanitiser stations on the field that you are free to use.</li> <li>• A nominated first aider will be present at the event. To minimise contact and possible cross contamination, we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers.</li> </ul>
<b>Toilets</b>	There will be access to the toilets in the pavilion, please be careful to respect distancing and wear your mask. There will be portable toilets behind the tent line. Please wipe down all touch points and use sanitiser before and after use of the facilities.
<b>Food &amp; Drink</b>	Please provide your own food and drink where possible and <b>take your rubbish home</b> . Takeaway hot food and drink will be available from the pavilion, subject to any regulations at the time.
<b>Camping</b>	Camping is <b>not</b> available on site.
<b>Pets</b>	Lilleshall do not allow dogs on their grounds unless they are working assistive dogs.
<b>Smoking</b>	Smoking is not permitted on the shooting field, please only smoke on the opposite side of the fence, near the parking area.
<b>Further Event Information</b>	World Archery Rules will apply. Archers will shoot on Damage bosses. Music may be played during the event.
<b>Procedure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You must ensure social distancing at all times.</li> <li>• Please keep bows and scopes in the waiting area boxes in front of the tents when not in use.</li> <li>• The first detail must remove scopes on the line after shootings, second detail can leave theirs for the next end, scopes should not be shared between households.</li> <li>• Archers on each target should decide who will perform the following roles at the target: Spotter, Check, Scorer, 2<sup>nd</sup> Scorer.</li> <li>• Only the scorers should touch their scoreboard at any time.</li> </ul>

- At the target there will be 4 spots on the ground at 2m apart. Please use these to aid you in maintaining social distancing.
- When scoresheets are to be handed in, they should be signed with your own pen, and the scorers will place the boards in a box near the DoS.
- We will be marking arrow holes. Archers should only mark and pull their own arrows, and only use their own pens and pullers.
- Archers that must stay on the line should bring a dedicated agent where possible, and if they are not the same household we recommend they use PPE and a quiver to reduce the contact with the archers equipment.
- Archers that cannot bring an agent but require one need to contact the tournament organiser before the shoot to arrange this.

#### Drugs

Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK Anti-Doping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.

#### GDPR

By entering Bucks or Bounty 2021 you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the year of 2021. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A target list will be published prior to the event in June 2021, available on the Bucks or Bounty website and lanseo. Up-to-date information will be available on lanseo. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible. If you enter the Bucks category and win a monetary prize, you will need to provide your bank details to receive your award.

#### Photos

Anyone wishing to take photos or videos on any device at this event must register with the organisers upon arrival.

#### Liability

Neither the Staffordshire County Archery Association, Bucks or Bounty team members, Judges, ArcheryGB or their agents and affiliated parties, nor Lilleshall National Sports Centre or their agents, servants or affiliated parties can accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
