<b>Venue</b>	Lilleshall National Sports and Conferencing Centre, Main Field, TF10 9AT
<b>Rounds</b>	<p>Saturday (Stage 1 of the AGB National Tour): WA720 and H2H            Sunday: World Archery Double 720            Timings: In line with World Archery's new rules archers will have 30 seconds per arrow on the Saturday, dependent on weather at the head judge and TO's discretion.            Sunday will be shot under 40 seconds per arrow timing as in previous years.</p>
<b>Faces</b>	<p>One 80cm 6-ring target for each compound archer (4 to a boss).            One 122cm face for non-compound archers.</p>
<b>Schedule</b>	<p>Line tents can be erected the night before the competition but no earlier than 5pm. No shooting will be available on the Friday night at this time.            Registration from 7:30am in cars – do not arrive before 7:30am! Equipment inspection will take place before or during practice.            Assembly will be at 8:45am and shooting will commence no later than 9:00am with a minimum of 20 minutes and no more than 3 ends of practice.</p>
<b>Bucks or Bounty</b>	You can enter into either the Bucks or the Bounty category. The Bounty category awards small trophies, the Bucks category awards monetary prizes. The U18 categories and archers shooting bow styles other than recurve or compound may not enter Bucks.
<b>Awards</b>	<p>Bounty: Small trophies to the top three for each gender, senior compound and barebow, and U18 and senior recurve.            Bucks: Monetary prizes to the top 25% in each of compound men, compound ladies, recurve men and recurve ladies. See the <a href="#">website</a> for a rundown of how the prize amounts are decided. More entries mean more money and more people winning it.  <i>(U18 recurves entering the senior category for the National Tour on Saturday may switch to the U18 round for the second day if they are participating in the Archery GB Youth Selection Shoot - this will make you ineligible for the Bucks or Bounty awards.)</i></p>
<b>Entry</b>	Entries will be run through <a href="#">Sport:80</a> . The entries open on Thursday 27 <sup>th</sup> January at 7pm, and 3 days earlier for archers ranked in the top 30 in the 2021 national rankings. The entry closing date is 2 <sup>nd</sup> April 2022.
<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	<p>Bounty entries are £43, Bucks entries are £50. No single day entries are available.            Refunds of 80% are granted to any archer that withdraws by 2<sup>nd</sup> April. No refunds will be granted after this date.</p>

<b>Event Information</b>	<p>World Archery Rules will apply.            There will be a cut off for the top 32 after the qualification round for the matches on Saturday.            Archers will shoot on Danage bosses. Music may be played during the event.            Toilets are located in the pavilion at one end of the field and portable toilets will be placed along the back of the field.            Hot food and drink will be provided by Lilleshall in the pavilion.            Please follow given directions regarding parking during the weekend. Two areas of disabled access parking will be operating.  <b>Camping is no longer available on site.</b></p>

Lilleshall do not permit dogs on their grounds unless they are registered working assistive dogs.

Smoking is not permitted on Lilleshall grounds.

We advise all archers to take their equipment away with them between shooting days rather than leaving equipment in their tents.

**COVID** The tournament will comply with all COVID restrictions on the date of the tournament. Please use the provided hand sanitising stations regularly and be respectful of everyone's space. In line with restrictions, spectators may be encouraged but asked to remain in certain areas.

**Liability** None of Stafford Archers, Bucks or Bounty team members, Judges, ArcheryGB or their agents and affiliated parties, nor Lilleshall National Sports Centre or their agents, servants or affiliated parties can accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.

**Drugs** Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK Anti-Doping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.

**GDPR** By entering Bucks or Bounty 2022 you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the year of 2022. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A target list will be published prior to the event in April 2022, available on the Bucks or Bounty website and lanseo. Up-to-date information will be mostly available on lanseo. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible. If you enter the Bucks category and win a monetary prize, you will need to provide your bank details upon request to receive your award.
